Environmental Policy

The Oaks Meadow Project will improve the environment with the planting of new woodland, orchard and gardens and the establishment of a wildlife pond. Within a four-acre site we will aim to increase biodiversity and create spaces where wildlife can thrive, alongside areas for public recreation that includes a play area for children.

Oaks Meadow Project CIO acknowledge that we have a responsibility to maintain an environmentally sensitive approach to the services we deliver.

We recognise that the quality of life in the longer term is dependent on the health and quality of the local and global environment.
