

OAKS MEADOW PRIVATE PARTY RULES

The Oaks Meadow Trustees welcome small party groups onto the meadow, but would ask you to abide by the rules as listed below.

1. Email oaksmeadow@gmail.com first to make sure there is no organised event taking place.
2. Keep party activities on the lower half of the meadow ie the play area, ball games area and picnic tables. The top half has garden spaces that are environmentally sensitive.
3. In the event that it rains, you may use the community garden shed as long as Wild Heritage Suffolk are not using it for their volunteers and the contents are respected and it is left as you found it.
4. Please do not decorate the equipment or any other feature on the meadow. This is an open community space to be enjoyed by everyone.
5. Strictly NO balloons, burst balloons are dangerous to the wildlife who live here.
6. Please take your party rubbish home. Oaks Meadow Volunteers have to empty the bins and take it back to their houses, we do not qualify for rubbish collections.
